- Addresses the **main question**: learning through experience vs. exams
- Gives **relevant reasons** and **at least one clear example/explanation**
- Appropriate length (150–200 words) and stays on topic

2. Organization: 3 points

- Clear **paragraph structure** (topic sentence → supporting ideas → concluding sentence)
- Ideas are logically developed and easy to follow
- Appropriate use of basic **linking words** (e.g. *firstly, for example, however, therefore*)

3. Language Use, Punctuation and Spelling: 4 points

- Generally accurate **grammar and sentence structures**
- Suitable vocabulary for an **opinion paragraph** at lower secondary level
- Errors do not seriously affect meaning
- Correct spelling and appropriate use of punctuation
